Eco-Squad Minutes: Tuesday 30th September

Congratulations to all for being voted as their classes Eco-rep.

Mr Scott shared the rota for fruit bin collections – to be completed at breaktime each day. The team then went and completed the first collection all together.

Shared individual environmental review. Mr Scott explained that everyone completes this and then from the findings of the review we create an action plan for the year. Mr Scott gave examples of what came from the review and what was changed. (e.g. now all food waste is collected separately, forest school area has wildflower area, litter picking completed by all children not just eco-squad)

Mr Scott handed out ‘WOW Ambassador’ badges. Each member is now an ambassador for Travel Tracker and ensuring their class is completing this each day.

Children shared other ideas for this year:

Further development of the forest school area and wildflower area
Development of raised beds and planting ‘crops’.
