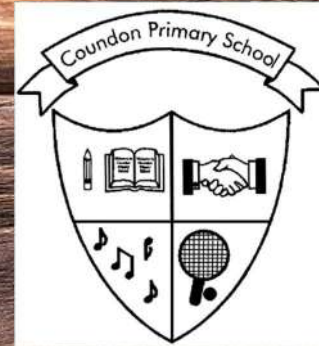


Spring Term in Year 1
