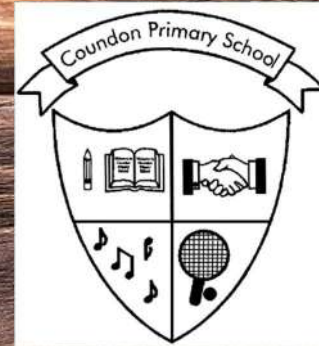


Spring Term in Year 4



English

Narrative – The Iron Man

The children will be exploring the opening chapter to the story of the incredible Iron Man. Using language to describe the character and learn how to build tension. They will then write the next part of the story.

Journalistic Writing

The children will look at the key features of a newspaper report (including language and layout) before writing an article about the discovery of an unknown sea creature killed from plastic pollution.

Poetry – Still I Rise

Children will write, analyse, perform and write poems about how to overcome difficult challenges in life including bullying.

Discovery

Romans Rule (with a focus on History)

Children will learn about the following;

- How the Romans invaded Britain and why, including Roman Emperors.
- Boudicca's revolt
- Beliefs of Romans (Gods and Goddesses)
- Roman army and soldiers
- Roman past times
- Impact the Romans left on Britain

Children will also take part in a Roman Wow day.

Multiplication and Division B

Music

Stop!

Continued- In this unit, children will listen to and appraise many songs about bullying. They will learn to sing and perform these songs and write their own song about bullying.

Glockenspiels – In this unit, children develop their understanding of the language of music by improving their playing skills on the glockenspiel building on prior learning and beginning to use simple musical notation through practical performance.

Lean on Me

In this unit, children will learn about the song Lean on Me. They will sing and play percussion instruments to accompany it.

Romans

4DP will also learn songs about the Romans for their class assembly.

PSHE

Dreams and Goals

In this unit, children explore the importance of having hope and dreams, how to deal when things don't go to plan. They will explore how a positive attitude will them and others to achieve their dreams and goals.

Healthy Me

In this unit, children explore what friendship means and the different roles within a friendship group. They will learn some facts about smoking and alcohol and their effect on health.

Children will create a Roman mosaic using collage.
