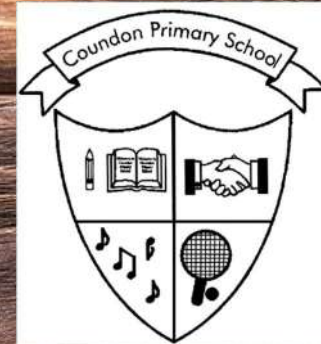


Autumn Term in Year 6

Children will write a travel brochure encouraging visitors to go to Greek attractions.

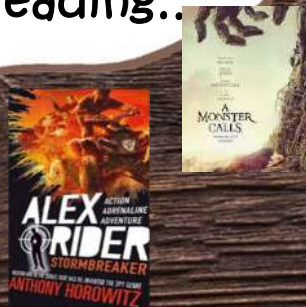
Greek Myths

Discovery

Ancient Greece

Children will take part in a WOW day where they will: write their name in the Greek alphabet, design pots, try some Greek food and learn about Greek clothing.

Children will also:

- Identify and describe geographical features.
- Use 4 and 6 figure grid references.
- Identify how the past influences the present.
- Present understanding of why people would want to visit Greece.
- Understand the role of archaeologists.
- Understand that no single sources of information can provide a full picture about the past.
- To undertake historical research and present findings in an original way.

Animals including humans (Healthy Bodies)

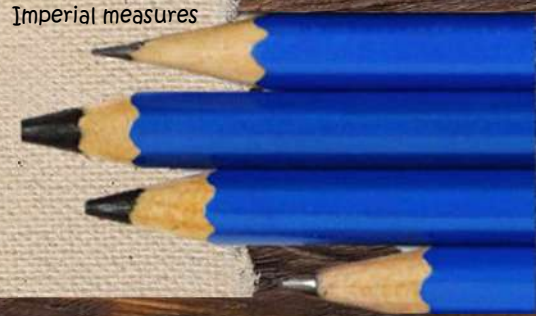
- Identify and name the main parts of the human circulatory system.

Art

Linked to our Discovery learning of Ancient Greece, children will:

- Draw Ancient Greek pots using observational drawing skills.
- Use research to influence the design and decoration of a modern pot based on those found in Ancient Greece.
- Construct and decorate a clay pot using coils or a thumb pot.

Spanish

Clothes

Children will describe a selection of different items of clothing; designing a bespoke outfit, giving reasons for clothes choices.

School life in Spanish

In this unit, children will learn the names of school subjects in Spanish; giving opinions about school subjects using Spanish adjectives; constructing their ideal school day timetable and writing a letter to their teacher using the key vocabulary they have learned within the unit.

Computing

Computing systems and networks: Bletchley Park

Discovering the history of Bletchley Park, historical figures, and computer science, children will learn about code-breaking and password hacking as well as decoding messages. Children will present information about historical figures.

Computing systems and networks: AI

Children will explore what AI is and how it generates text, images and code. They will learn about creating and refining prompts to improve AI responses while also considering the ethical implications of AI and its potential to replace human roles.
